Like all other insects, ants have 6 legs. They are very strong. They have 2 stomachs. They do not have ears. They feel with their feet. They live in groups and have different jobs. 



When I woke up next morning, I couldn't move. My arms and legs were tied to the ground!


I was surprised. I saw a little man on my chest! He was very small.

I stayed in England for two months, then I returned to sea. I was the ship's doctor. I left England on 20th June, 1702.



Finally, on 3rd June 1706 I returned to England. I was very happy to be home. I don't want any more adventures!




### Joha and the Donkey

One day, Joha went to his neighbour's house. He wanted to borrow a kettle. Joha's neighbour gave him the kettle. The next day, Joha returned the kettle.



We use the present simple for something that is always true. We use the present continuous to talk about something that is happening at the time of speaking.


